3. <u>Jesus answered and said to him, "M</u>ost assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

4. <u>Nicodemus said</u> to Him, "How can a man be born when he is **old**? Can he enter a **second** time into his **mother's womb** and be born?"

5. <u>Jesus answered</u>, <u>"M</u>ost assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.

6. <u>*That whi*</u>ch is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit.

7. <u>Do not marvel that I said to you</u>, "You must be born again."

8. <u>*The* w</u>ind blows where it wishes, and you hear the sound of it, but cannot tell where it comes from and where it goes. So is everyone who is born of the Spirit."

9. <u>Nicodemus and said to Him</u>, "How can these things be?"

10. *Jesus answered and said to him, "A*re you the teacher of Israel, and do not know these things?

11. <u>Most assuredly, I say to you, W</u>e speak what We know and testify what We have seen, and you do not receive **Our** witness.

4. <u>For an</u> **angel** went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever **stepped** in first, after the **stirring** of the water, was made well of whatever **disease** he had.

5. <u>Now a</u> certain man was there who had an **infirmity** thirty-eight years.

6. <u>When</u> Jesus saw him **lying** there, and **knew** that he already had been in that **condition** a long time, He said to him, "Do you **want** to be made well?"

- Note 1: Whenever a question or answer requires "God" the quizzer may instead use "The Father" and vice-versa. Likewise, "the Son" may be used instead of "Jesus" and vice-versa. This applies to all of the material, not just specific verses. There is **one exception** to this. In John 1:1, the second time God is used it is not referring to "the Father". For example, the question "In a verse 1, Who was the Word?", the answer is God. Answering (or adding) "the Father" is **incorrect**.
